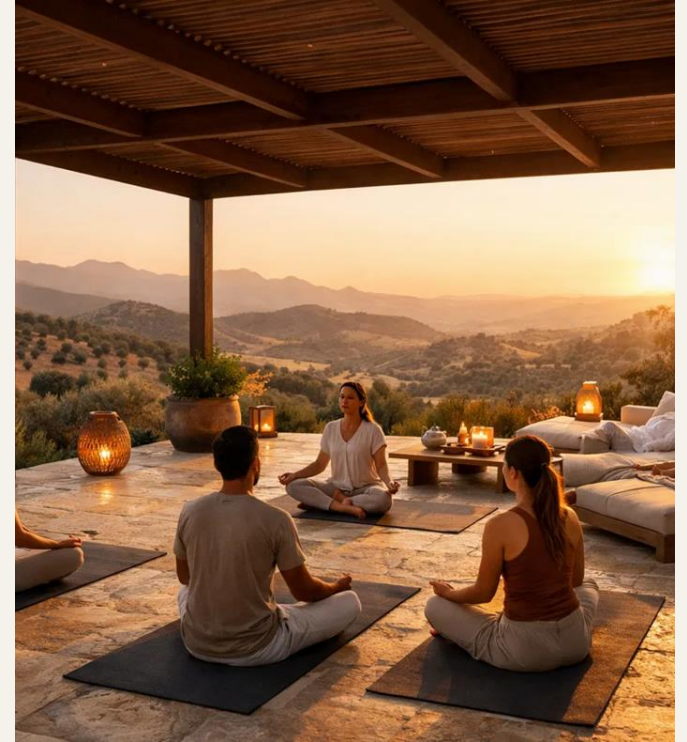

Sample Schedule

Days are intentionally paced: morning practice, nourishing meals, time in nature, spacious afternoons, and evenings designed for restoration and connection. Every detail — accommodations, meals, excursions, and support — is handled so guests feel held from arrival to departure.

Pricing Philosophy & Guest Ranges

Wildwell retreats are priced transparently and sustainably, ensuring fair compensation for hosts while valuing local vendors, guides, chefs, and artisans.

Typical guest pricing:

\$3,200 – \$8,500 per guest

(depending on destination, duration, and inclusions)

Partner compensation is structured through revenue-sharing or hosted travel experiences, discussed clearly during the proposal stage.

Hosting a retreat with Wildwell is designed to be financially viable, transparent, and aligned with the effort you put into building your group.

Each retreat is structured so that core costs are covered first. As enrollment grows beyond that threshold, additional guests unlock increased host earnings.

Illustrative example (varies by destination and tier):

- At 8 guests, a retreat typically reaches operational break-even
- **At 10–12 guests, host earnings often range from \$4,000–\$12,000+** depending on pricing and structure

This model rewards community engagement while ensuring the retreat remains sustainable for all parties involved. Final economics are always confirmed in a custom proposal, with clear numbers before bookings open.

This tier includes thoughtfully selected accommodations, daily retreat programming, and core logistics that ensure the experience runs smoothly. Meals and excursions are included where appropriate, with optional upgrades available depending on destination and venue.

Signature

\$4,500 - \$6,500 per participant

Wildwell's flagship retreat experience. It is designed for hosts who want to offer an elevated, all-inclusive retreat with a stronger emphasis on comfort, culinary experiences, and curated excursions.

Signature retreats typically include upgraded accommodations, three thoughtfully prepared meals per day, multiple guided experiences, and enhanced on-site support. \$6,500+ per participant

Designed for highly personalized, high-touch retreats serving smaller or premium audiences, best suited for executive groups, private communities, or hosts offering an ultra-personalized experience where discretion, privacy, and customization are paramount.

These retreats often feature private accommodations for all guests, bespoke experiences, and fully customized programming. Every element — from lodging to meals to excursions — is tailored specifically to the group, with maximum flexibility and exclusivity.

FAQs from Prospective Hosts



1. What is the minimum group size?

Typically 10–12 guests is encouraged (though 8 is the baseline), varying by destination and venue. We work with you to determine a financially viable and intimate group size that ensures a high-quality experience.

2. What if the retreat doesn't fill?

We have a clear, transparent process discussed during the proposal stage. We always work together to find the best solution, whether that means adjusting the plan or rescheduling.

3. Can I co-host with another facilitator?

Yes. Collaboration brings unique dynamics and can expand your reach. Terms, roles, and revenue splits are clearly outlined in our collaboration agreement.

4. How are guest payments handled?

Wildwell manages all payments through our secure booking platform with various payment options including payment plans. You will not be responsible for collecting or managing any guest payments.

5. Can I host multiple retreats per year?

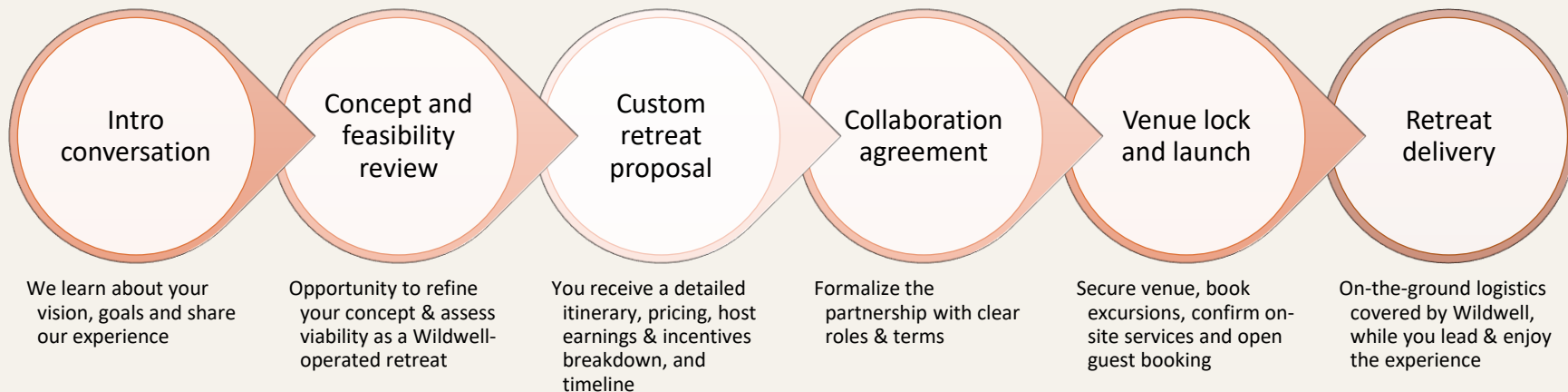
Absolutely. We support long-term partnerships and help you create sustainable, scalable models that allow you to offer multiple retreats without burnout.
